General Information

In order to serve the 300+ young people and adults coming to Freeride 2011, October 21st through October 23rd, at the NorthBay Retreat Center in Northeast, MD, we will need to have at least 25 Work Crew staff assembled. We already have several commitments, and the remaining adults will be accepted as space is available.

As a Crew member, you will be serving for 4 meals during the weekend, which include 3 meals on Saturday and 1 meal on Sunday. You can arrive any time on Friday, and are welcome to attend all of the event programming when you are not needed in the dining facilities. All Crew Members will gather during the Adult Reception on Friday night that begins at 9:15pm.

Frequently Asked Questions

WHERE WILL WE BE STAYING?

Work crew will be housed together with other adults, unless the participant's church has a group at the event and prefers to be housed with them. Based on feedback for 2010, all Work Crew will be housed together in the cabins closest to the Dining Hall, apart from regular FreeRide participants unless you request to stay with the participants from your church.

IS THERE ANY COST?

Work Crew come to the event for free, and will still receive an event t-shirt!

I'M ALREADY COMING AS AN ADULT WITH MY CHURCH. CAN I STILL SERVE?

NorthBay requires that those adults coming to serve as the Work Crew stay in the role throughout the weekend. You must choose between serving as an adult with your group or serving on the Work Crew. Work Crew adults do not count towards the required adult:youth ratios for the event.
