General Information

In order to serve the 300+ young people and adults coming to FreeRide October 19-21, 2018, at the NorthBay Retreat Center in North East, Maryland, we will need to have at least 30 Work Crew staff assembled.

As a Crew member, you will be serving for four meals during the weekend, which include three meals on Saturday and one meal on Sunday. You can arrive any time on Friday, and are welcome to attend all of the event programming when you are not needed in the dining facilities. All Work Crew members will gather on Friday evening at 9:15 p.m. for an adult reception and orientation.

Frequently Asked Questions

Where will we be staying?

Work Crew will be housed together with other Work Crew volunteers. Based on feedback from previous years, all Work Crew will be housed together in the cabins closest to the Dining Hall, apart from regular FreeRide participants, unless you request to stay with the participants from your church. This enables you to rest in a quiet space between meals if desired, and ensures that you can turn in as early as you'd like.

Is there any cost?

Work Crew attend the event for free, and will still receive an event t-shirt!

I'm already coming as an adult with my church. Can I still serve?

NorthBay requires that those adults coming to serve as the Work Crew stay in the role throughout the weekend. You must choose between serving as an adult with your group or serving on the Work Crew. Work Crew adults do not count towards the required adult:youth ratios for the event.
